



Founded in AD122, for almost three centuries, Hadrian's Wall was a vibrant, multi-cultural frontier sprawling some 80 miles coast-to-coast with a further 70 miles of coastal defences down the Cumbrian Coast. Up to six metres high and with a frontier garrison of around 20,000 soldiers from across the empire, it is as astounding today for its sheer vision as it is for its engineering. Forts, milecastles, ramparts, barracks and civil settlements punctuate the route and the landscapes of the Whin Sill whilst Cumbria and Tyneside provide a dramatic backdrop. Join us in 2022 to celebrate 1900 years since the building of Hadrian's Wall with hundreds of events and activities taking place in a yearlong festival across Hadrian's Wall World Heritage Site.




Ravenglass Roman Bath House

1/4 mile south east of Ravenglass, off a minor road leading to the A595 Never was an ancient army so clean! The bath house walls here are amongst the tallest surviving remains along the Frontier. The remarkably well preserved remains are associated with the Roman for of Ravenglass, established in AD130 on the site of a slightly earlier fortlet. The monument is significant because so few Roman buildings n Britain survive to such a height, with windows, doorways, niche and internal rendering still adhering to wall surfaces in many places.




Lanercost Priory

he beautiful and now tranquil setting of Augustinian Lanercost Priory belies an often troubled history. Standing close to Hadrian's Wall, it suffered frequent attacks during the long Anglo-Scottish wars, once by Robert Bruce in person. There is still much to see in one of the best preserved of Cumbrian monasteries. The east end of the noble 13th century church survives to its full height, housing within its dramatic triple tier of arches some fine monuments.
