 You can experience and learn Hiroshima at this new place. Enjoy the wide open scenery of Hiroshima and pray for the world peace as you put your orizuru into the wall of orizuru. We also have a shoppe and cafe.  
 10:00-19:00 \*This may vary by season.  
 Last entry to the Observation Deck: 1 hour before closing time.  
 Experience Zone (Spiral Slope and Viewing Decks) Adults: 1,700yen  
 An additional fee of 500 yen is required for making an origami crane and tossing it into the Orizuru Wall on 12F. (The fee is 600 yen when applied for separately on 12F)

**Hiroshima River Cruise & Hiroshima World Heritage Sea Route [D2]**  
 The river cruise offers you wonderful views of Hiroshima, the "City of Water". The World Heritage sea route (from the Atomic Bomb Dome to Miyajima) is also attractive.

**Hiroshima Castle [B4]**  
 This castle was completed in 1598. Its tower was destroyed by the A-bomb, and rebuilt in 1958. The inside of the castle now serves as a history museum focusing on samurai culture

**Hiroshima Museum of Art [C3]**

**Hiroshima Prefectural Art Museum [B4]**  
 This museum mainly owns and displays works by artists related to Hiroshima and artworks from the 1920s-1930s. From this museum, you can enjoy a view of neighboring Shukkeien Garden.

**Shukkeien Garden [A5]**  
 This Japanese-style landscape garden with a pond and a circular path around it was owned by the local feudal lord family in the Edo period. You can enjoy different views in different seasons here.

**Hiroshima meipuru-pu (Route and timetable)**  
 Orange route (stopping at 3 museums)  
 One circuit: 47 min.  
 Hiroshima Sta. Shinkansen-guchi exit: 9:00 - 17:00 (last bus)  
 Last bus: 17:00

**Green route**  
 One circuit: 33 min.  
 Hiroshima Sta. Shinkansen-guchi Exit: 9:30-17:30 (last bus)  
 Hiroshima Sta. Shinkansen-guchi exit: 9:00 - 17:45 (last bus)

**Blue route**  
 One circuit: 40 min.  
 Hiroshima Sta. Shinkansen-guchi exit: 9:00 - 17:45 (last bus)

All buses on the three routes stop at the A-bomb Dome and Hiroshima Peace Memorial Park. Hiroshima Free Wi-Fi is available on the bus.
